## II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

# III. MISHAP SUMMARIES

Keith Cox presented claims for FY 2021-22 totaling 463, claims for FY 2022-23 totaling 489 to date, showing a six percent increase. He also displayed top ten claims by occupation for FY 2022-23 to date, top ten injury cause/cost for FY 2022-23, and claims by occupation/type of injury. Reese Thompson requested an agenda item for the next meeting to discuss how to approach injuries. He would like to target one job title/injury and take it to the board for guidance and direction on how to target efforts to lower injuries. Amber Anderson agreed it was an excellent point to make to the board for strategic planning.
